The Chukar Golf Tournament

Welcome Tournament Participants,

On behalf of The Chukar Tournament Committee, and staff of the Kendrick Golf Course, it is our pleasure to welcome you to the inaugural Chukar Golf Tournament.

The first event of The Chukar will be the Thursday Practice Round. The Practice Round will include a team best ball game for \$60 per team and there will be both gross and net payouts. Participation is optional. At 5:30 we will kick off the 8th Annual Tony Markve Memorial Slug Fest" starting on the #10 teeing area. Cost is \$25 and play hard because its winner takes all! Thursday night at 6:30p.m. we invite you to attend the opening cocktail hour and dinner brought to you by McGregor's Bar and Grill at Mydland Market under the tent with a Calcutta to follow around 7:30p.m.

The tournament field is 46 teams equaling 92 players. Friday commences at 8:00am with a Bloody Mary bar sponsored by The Pony Grill and Bar under the tent. Along with that, will be serving up some short stacks at the first annual Chukar Pancake Feed and live music by Brock Finn. The driving range will open at 8:00 so please allow yourself enough time to get "loose" for the **10:00 a.m. shotgun start**. We will be playing a combination of 9-holes of team Best Ball and 9-holes of Chapman formats each day to combine for one 18-hole team score. Refer a few pages back for more information on each format. Dinner Friday evening is on your own, we encourage you to venture downtown to our local Sheridan establishments.

On Saturday, the festivities resume at 8:00am with "Kegs and Eggs" under the tent along with the Bloody Mary Bar sponsored by The Pony Grill and Bar. While preparing, you will be hit with a strong dose of 80's hair metal...enjoy. Tournament play again kicks off at 10:00am with the final round, which will again be a combination of Best Ball and Chapman formats. Upon the completion of play, the 1st and 2nd low gross and low net teams from each flight will come together for the Championship Chukar Shoot, a 7-hole derby to determine this year's tournament champions. Following the Shootout pizza and beer will be provided courtesy of Powder River Pizza and Pub, Black Tooth Brewing Company, and Bison Beverage.

Tournament Format and Rules

This year we have 46 teams broken into 5 flights of roughly 9 teams in each. Flights will be determined by the combined player handicap index. All flights will be playing from the Chukar & Chuckie tee markers.

Formats:

The tournament format will be nine holes of best ball and nine holes of chapman each day, for a total of 18 holes of each format.

Best Ball Format: Golfers play their own ball and card their own individual score for each hole. Then, the team records the best gross and net score from amongst their team to be used as the "team score" for that hole.

Chapman Format: Both golfers on the team hit drives; Each plays the other's ball for the second shots; The best of the second shots is selected, and from there the two partners play alternate shot into the hole until completed.

Handicapping:

All handicap indexes are as of July 18th. The maximum course handicap for any player will be 36, and each player will be receiving 100% of their GHIN Index for Best Ball Format. For the Chapman Format teams will receive 60% of the low handicap and 40% of the higher player's handicap. The tournament committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps should it deem necessary.

Pace of Play:

To ensure that we get all the matches and the shootout completed, we ask that all teams abide by the following:

- 1) When out of the hole please pick up.
- 2) Pace of play guidelines are as follows: maximum per hole of 15 minutes or 2 hours and 15 minutes total for the nine holes.

Breaking Ties:

Ties for first place in the flight will be determined by a chip off. If there is a tie for second and third place in the flight it will be determined by a one-hole, sudden death playoff. Should there still be a tie after completion of the one-hole playoff, there will be a chip off to determine 2nd place in the flight.

Weather Policy:

In case of inclement weather all 18 holes must be completed for the score to count. If 18 holes is not completed the tournament will be shortened to the number of complete rounds.


